Uniform Statement and Policy

Elite Academy School of Excellence has adopted a **mandatory school uniform program**. School colors are **Black and White** (gray T-shirts for P.E.). Students have **five days** after enrollment to comply. Disciplinary consequences apply for non-compliance.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS BY GENDER

Girls	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Black or white polo short-sleeve shirts• Black or khaki pants / capri shorts only• Shirts must be tucked in at all times during school and school functions
Boys	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• White or black button-up short-sleeve polo shirts• Black or khaki pants only• Belt required; pants worn at waist; shirts tucked in at all times
Wednesday	All-white button-up dress shirts for ALL students.
Spirit Day (Fri)	Denim pants may be worn with school spirit shirts on the last school day of each week.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What does the mandatory uniform policy mean?

All students dress in designated attire so that appearance does not interfere with or disrupt the educational environment.

2. Are students required to follow the uniform policy?

Yes. All enrolled students are required to comply.

3. Why are students required to wear uniforms?

Uniforms promote safety, improve discipline, and enhance the learning environment.

4. Can a parent request an exemption?

Yes. Exemptions may be requested for bona fide documented reasons or financial hardship at registration (new students) or within the first ten school days. Exemptions are valid for the current year only; a new request is required each year. An approved exemption card must be carried by the student at all times. Forms are available in the main office.

5. What clothing is acceptable if an exemption is granted?

Students must follow the Student Code of Conduct Dress Code guidelines (pages 18–19 of the Parent/Student Handbook).

6. Is financial assistance available for uniforms?

Yes. Contact the Directors and arrangements will be made for families with demonstrated financial need.

7. What happens if a student is out of compliance?

First offense: family is contacted and a warning is issued. If the problem persists, a formal write-up is issued. After three write-ups the student may be withdrawn.



8. What clothing or accessories are considered inappropriate?

Jeans (except on spirit days), shorts, oversized clothing, tight/form-fitting pants, chains, spikes, headbands, bandanas, long dangling belts; gang, drug, or satanic paraphernalia; tattered or torn clothing, frayed/cropped pants, cut-offs, midriiffs, or unbuckled pants; long dangling earrings, hats, or sunglasses (except during P.E.).

The School Board of Florida prohibits any policy or procedure that results in discrimination on the basis of age, ethnicity, disability, gender, marital status, religion, or sexual orientation.

Bus Safety Rules and Procedures

Statistics have proven that children riding in a school bus are significantly safer than those who travel in privately-owned vehicles. Due to regulated bus construction, public transportation is the safest means of travel for students. **School bus transportation is a privilege in the State of Florida** — there is no obligation for a school district to provide transportation to regular education students. Students who repeatedly or seriously disregard these rules may lose this privilege.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Arrive at your assigned bus stop **at least five minutes** before the scheduled arrival. The bus cannot wait for late arrivals.
2. Respect the property adjoining the bus stop — do not trespass.
3. Wait for the bus in a safe place well off the roadway.
4. Parents must drop off and pick up children at assigned locations or on the same side of the road as the bus.
5. Students will be let off the bus only at the school or designated stops.
6. Go directly to your assigned seat without crowding or pushing.
7. Remain seated in assigned seats at all times while the bus is in motion.
8. Do not extend arms, legs, hands, or any objects out of bus windows.
9. Do not vandalize the bus or any equipment on the bus.
10. Act respectfully toward the driver and be courteous to all riders. Violence (fighting, scuffling, throwing objects, etc.) will not be tolerated under any circumstance.
11. Do not open windows or emergency doors except at the direction of the bus driver.
12. Keep books, lunch boxes, instruments, and all other items out of the aisles.
13. Whether food or drinks are allowed is at the discretion of the bus driver. If you eat on the bus, you must clean up after yourself.
14. Talking in a conversational tone is permitted. Yelling is not allowed.
